
Adopt a Drain! Sweep up! Rake up! Pick up!


The Bloomington LWV participates in the Adopt-a-Drain program and encourages Bloomington residents to join also.

Volunteer fifteen minutes, twice a month, for cleaner waterways and healthier communities. Storm drains flow directly to local lakes, rivers, rivers, and wetlands, acting as a conduit for trash and organic pollutants. Adopt-a-Drain asks residents to adopt a storm drain in their neighborhood and keep it clear of leaves, trash, and other debris to reduce water pollution.

Restore the Vote: Putting the New Law into Action

What is the Equal Rights Amendment - And Why Do We Still Need It?

One of LWVB'S 2023 goals is "DEMOCRACY". Our March 7 Member meeting centered around the Equal Rights Amendment.



GUEST SPEAKER: Suzanne Willhite, President of ERA Minnesota

<u>ERA Minnesota</u>, a nonprofit volunteer organization, is working to add an Equal Rights Amendment to the Minnesota Constitution through a ballot measure passed by popular vote. In addition, it joins efforts nationwide to enact the ratification of the ERA as the 28th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. The ERA Minnesota is a partner of the LWV Minnesota.

"The ERA will empower Congress to pass laws that protect against discrimination and give people the power to fight discrimination in the workplace. Those aren't radical ideas. They are popular ones."

Neither the U.S. Constitution nor the Minnesota Constitution mandates gender equality. The fight to add an Equal Rights Amendment has lasted 100 years.

The Equal Rights Amendment reads:

Section 1: Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any state on account of sex.

Section 2: The Congress shall have the power to enforce, with appropriate legislation, the provisions of this article.

Section 3: This amendment shall take effect two years after the date of ratification.

In 1923 suffragists whose work helped women get the right to vote in 1919 developed what became known as the ERA, a movement to enshrine full equality in the U.S. Constitution regardless of sex. After a long campaign, in 1972 the ERA was passed by both the Senate and the House in 1972. All that was left was for the states to ratify it.

More recently (2017-2020), a renewed push earned the needed ratification by 38 states, and four additional states have adopted ERAs.

DEMAGOGUE

We've repeatedly heard the term "demagogue" in the media and blogosphere, and in political discourse. So just who is a demagogue?

You probably know it refers to a charismatic political <u>leader</u> (or wannabe) whose vociferous words and outspoken opinions are persuasive to many people, but are found to be offensive or threatening by others.

Demagogues tend to be <u>narcissistic</u> and authoritarian, as well as brazen, bombastic and belligerent. Their vitriol appeals to the vulnerable and darker places in psyches and hearts. They fuel emotional fires in their zealous followers with sentiments of prejudice, bigotry, hate, hyper-patriotism, and xenophobia. Source: Psychology Today
